Overview of the College Landscape





- Government College, Barotiwala came into existence through HP Govt. notification EDN -A- Kha (1)-1/2015 dated 29 May 2015. It became functioning on 10 June 2015 with the beginning of the academic session 2015-16.
- The college was functioning at Government Senior Secondary School Barotiwala for almost 7 years. The new campus building was inaugurated in September 2022 by the then Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Jai Ram Thakur in Buranwala, Barotiwala. The classes became functional from April 2023 at new building after inauguration of classes by Hon'ble CPS Sh. Ram Kumar Chaudhary.
- Presently, the college provides education in Arts and Commerce streams with the help of well qualified, experienced and committed teaching staff. The programmes are being run in accordance with H.P. University, Shimla guidelines and directions of the state Government.
- The college has a total number of 12 sanctioned posts in teaching faculty and out of these 01 is lying vacant. In non-teaching staff the college has 11 sanctioned posts and out of which 08 are filled and 03 are lying vacant.
- Mr Rajinder Sharma retired as the Principal on 31st January 2024.
- Dr Anjori Sharma joined as the Principal Govt.College Barotiwala on 1st Feburary 2024 from Govt College Beetan.
- Dr Sunita Goyal got promoted as Principal and joined Govt. College Beetan.
- Prof Rajkumari Chandel retired on 29th February, 2024. Her dedication and contributions were applauded and she was honored for her invaluable service to the institution.
- Prof Gunjan Hazri from English Dept. got transferred to Vallabh Govt. College Mandi. Dr Shishu Bala and Dr Suneela Sharma joined the English Department of College on 9th March 2024.

IQAC

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell under the able supervision of Dr Anupama S Pathak is putting efforts in planning, guiding and monitoring Quality Assurance (QA) and Quality Enhancement (QE) activities of the colleges. IQAC is developing and applying quality benchmarks for academic and administrative activities of the institution. The departments conduct and carry out the activities as per the institutional procedures. The IQAC has also brought improvement in strategies in facilitating the learner-centric environment towards quality education and faculty development.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

National Service Scheme popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in the Gandhi centenary year, 1969 and was aimed at developing the personality of students through community service. Dr Niti Gupta is the

NSS Program Officer and Shri Naveen Singh is the **Office Incharge**. The college has 100 volunteers for the NSS unit in the current year 2023-24 as per the guidelines given by Himachal Pradesh University. The following programmes were initiated by the unit.

- Cleanliness Drive was organized in the college campus on 6th and 30th
 of September 2023. During these camps volunteers cleaned the
 college campus and surrounding areas.
- To promote "green earth" tree plantation drives were organised in the college campus on October 4th ,5th and1st November. More than 50 plants were planted.
- A one-day camp was organised on 26th February 2024 in which volunteers cleaned the playground and surrounding areas and also prepared the ground for annual athletic meet.
- "My First Vote for the Country" campaign was organised in the campus on 6th March 2024 in which first time voters were motivated to come forward and exercise their democratic right to vote. After administering the oath to the students in this regard, a Slogan writing competition organised under this campaign.





Road Safety Club

Road Safety Club serves as a platform to engage and educate students on various aspects of road safety to reduce accidents and promote responsible behaviour among road users. In her capacity as convenor, Prof Krishna Prakash manages the affairs of the Road safety Club. Under this club different activities were organised to raise awareness and promote a culture of safe driving;

- Quiz competition was held on 2/11/23 on to raise the awareness about traffic signals etc.
- Essay writing competition was held in college campus on 4/11/2023
- A Nukad Natak on the theme "Sadak Suraksha Jiwan Raksha" was organised by Road Safety Club on 29 / 11/23 in collaboration with RTO office Nalagarh.
- On 18/12/2023 road safety club organised health check-up camp with collaboration of East Man Auto Power Ltd. In which Dr.Manisha addressed the students and then various routine body tests were done.

Career Guidance and Placement Cell

Career Guidance and Placement Cell of the college has been playing an important role in guiding the students about their career and tries it's best to equip the students with the necessary life skills irrespective of their background. In her role as the convenor, Prof Pallavi Chauhan spearheads the initiatives of the Cell. The following initiatives were taken under the cell this session:

 There was a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Nimbus Academy and Govt. College Barotiwala to guide students for various exams. The cell organised a Guest Lecture on Career Planning and Goal setting on 18th September 2023 in collaboration with Nimbus Academy Chandigarh.





- The cell organised a special lecture on opportunities as a Make- up Artist and Self Grooming Tips. To provide our students a glimpse into the world of professional and skilled makeup artistry Ms Ritu Singh from Kaya Kalap Herbals Baddi was invited in the college.
- Career Counselling and Placement Cell of in collaboration with Job Coach organised a job fair in 27th December 2023. The team from Job coach headed by Prof ML Sahani conducted a workshop with students.
- The cell conducted Mock Interviews/ Interview Guidance for BCom/BA 3rd year students(on 26th & 27th February & 7th March 2024). The following points were highlighted and recommended to the students: 1. Skill Development 2. Confidence Building 3. Reducing Anxiety 4. Identification of Strengths and Weaknesses.
- The Cell organized a special lecture on "Navigating Examination Stress and an Overview of various Competitive Exams" in collaboration with Chanakya Academy, Chandigarh, on 11th March 2024. The session emphasized effective ways to manage exam stress and provided insights into how students can prepare for various competitive exams.
- A second lecture on "Interview Skills and various options after Graduation" was conducted in collaboration with Baddi. This session aimed to equip students with valuable skills for job interviews and presented different career paths available post-graduation.

Anti-Drugs Club / Drug Prevention Squad

The Primary objective of an Anti-Drugs club in colleges is to create a supportive and an empowering environment that encourages students to make informed choices and live a healthy, drug -free lives. The Drug Prevention Squad in Govt. College, Barotiwala has been working under the able guidance of Dr Tripta Sharma sensitising the students about drug prevention and addiction.

- The students were also delivered a lecture about drug addiction during orientation programme and during career counselling session on 18.09.23.
- The club also had a collaborative session with the road safety club and a lecture by the doctor along with his team on drug addiction was held on 18.12.23.
- A talk was delivered on drug abuse on 14/3/24 followed by an open discussion on the same. A short movie on drug addiction was also shown to the students.

Scholarship Committee

The scholarship committee under Prof Visheshar Lal undertook various activities to create awareness among students. A special lecture titled "National Scholarship Portal (NSP) and Scholarship Schemes: An Introduction" was organized to provide an overview of available opportunities. Additionally, the scholarship committee delivered lectures in classrooms to further inform students about the available scholarship options. In academic session of 2023-24, a total of six applications were received under various scholarship schemes.

Rovers and Rangers

Our college has one unit each of Rovers and Rangers functioning under the guidance of Prof Visheshar Lal and Dr Isha Dhiman.

The magazine aims to offer students an open platform to express their creativity freely through articles, poems, photos, slogans, and posters. Electoral Literacy Club

- An awareness programme for the women staff was organized and the staff was made familiar with POSH act on 26th February 2024.
- A "chai pe charcha" was conducted on 09th March 2024. where women staff discussed about their experiences and lessons learnt.

Infrastructural Development

Highlights of the works done in the college during this session:

- Three Sitars, one Harmonium, one Dholak, one Synthesizer, 9 Sheets were bought for the Music Department.
- 3 Water Purifiers, 04 overflow Sensors, 15 CCTV cameras, one Biometric machine and one LED were installed in the college campus.
- A grant of Rs 100,000 has been allocated for the college library and additional Rs 150,000 has been received for the music department from the Directorate.

Torrent Pharmaceuticals has generously donated 70 desks to the college. The Himalayan Social Institute, an NGO, has contributed 100 desks . Asian Concrete and Cements Ltd has provided 120 fixed desks to furnish 6 lecture halls in the college. Prime Steel Pvt Ltd contributed 2 computer tables,10 office chairs, 2 revolving chairs and 4 working tables. We highly acknowledge and appreciate their contribution.

Library

College Library serves as a centralized hub of information, providing resources, support and space for intellectual growth and development. The college has a library that is in progress and is evolving with the Librarian Mrs Kamlesh Sharma providing capable direction .The Library currently has 1140 books. The college subscribes 06 Newspapers, 06 Magazines and 02 Journals.

Diverse Engagements

- Orientation Program for BA / B Com first year students was organised on 12 th October 2024 to make them aware of the College rules, activities, Clubs, CBCS- UGC (RUSA) and other issues.
