### **Career Council and Placement Cell**

#### **A Report Activities and Plan of action in the session 2024 -25**

A Career Counselling and Placement Cell in a college serves the primary purpose of guiding students in choosing suitable career paths by assessing their interests, skills and aspirations. At the same time the cell facilitates connections of students with potential employers through Industrial visits , Internships and Campus placement drives.

The career counselling and placement cell of Barotiwala College has been actively functioning as per the SOPs and Guidelines set for the colleges since August 2023. This year, the members of the Cell, under the chairmanship of the Principal, Dr Anjori Sharma are as follows:-

In this session of 2024-25 following Plan of action was submitted to the chairperson and activities have been organised as per the plan chalked out :-

A meeting of the Career Counselling and Placement cell was held in the College staffroom on August 30<sup>th</sup> at 1pm. Following decisions were taken after a discussion between the members present during the meeting:-

**That the Plan of Action for the session 2024-25 will be as under:-**

1. Registration and Industrial tie-ups

Registration forms for enrolment with the CCPC will be filled by the students of the BCom 3<sup>rd</sup> year and BA 3<sup>rd</sup> year in the beginning of the session . The members of the cell will select, visit and secure agreements and MOUs with the best companies and industries.

## 2. Lectures

Weekly lectures of highly qualified professionals and interactive sessions with representatives of Industry will be organized in the months of September, October and December. Data of feedback of the students will be collected.

## 3. Industrial visits

Industrial visits will be organized and students will make visits to various kinds of industry namely – Banking, Textiles, metal, Hospitality, Medical ,etc. These visits will provide an in-depth knowledge and understanding of the skills and qualifications required for employability in the various fields and professions to the students.

## 4. Resume making

Workshops of Resume-making will be organized in the college to ensure a hands-on skill in preparation of a good Resume for the students.

## 5. Internship and skill training

Based on the industrial visits a one month schedule for voluntary Internship/Apprenticeship will be formalized and students will be enrolled therewith only on voluntary basis. Students will get a hands-on training and experience along with a certificate from the industry where they enroll for the internship.

## 6. Mock Interviews

Workshops Interview training and skill along with the actual Mock interviews will be organized in the month of February. This will prepare the students for a step further in adding confidence to their personality.

## 7. Job Fair

A Job Fair will organize in the month of March, inviting various companies and Industries to participate and interview our students. This shall provide a platform to our students not only for employment but provide a data bank to all the participating stake holders for future opportunities of hiring as well as employment.

Following activities have been organised so far in the college by CC&PC under the prescribed SOPs:-

**1. Registration of student- members** for the session 2024-25. About 70 students from BA final year and BCom final year have been registered as members of the cell,

### **2. Industrial trip by our team for MOUs**

An Industrial trip led by Dr. Suneela, Pallavi, and Dr. Ina on April 19<sup>th</sup>2024 was undertaken . This trip aimed to establish collaborative ties between Government College Barotiwala and local industries, fostering mutually beneficial partnerships.

3. Recruitment Drives: Facilitating recruitment events to connect talented graduates with organizations seeking suitable candidates.
