Vision

The Road Safety Club aims to cultivate a culture of responsible and safe driving practices among college students in Himachal Pradesh. Highlights of Activities -July to December 2024

1. The First Annual Orientation / Enrolment Meet

The First Annual Orientation / Enrolment Meet of the Road Safety Club for the academic year 2024-25 was successfully held at on 31st August 2024. The event commenced at 1:30 PM in Room No. 001, with enthusiastic participation from students and faculty members.


Learning Outcome:
