Walk with message on HIV

On 06-12-2024, the RRC GC Barotiwala organized a WALK WITH MESSAGE ON HIV as part of World AIDS Day Campaign. The walk aimed to spread the message o prevention, awareness and eliminating stigma associated with HIV/AIDS. Participants carried banners and playcards with messages like: Know your Status: Get tested , Stop Stigma:Spread Love, Prevention is better than cure.

Participants gathered in college campus after the walk to create symbolic Red Ribbon. Volunteers pinned red ribbons on students, faculty and staff to express solidarity and support for the cause.
