#### 2 Co-Curricular Activities:

Debate Club "Samvad": In October 2023, Department of Political Science, and the Department of History of Government College, Barotiwala, established a debate club named "Samvad," The club aims to foster critical thinking and scientific temperament among students. The following activities were conducted under

the aegis of this club such as debate on "Women Reservation Act 2023: Issues and Challenges", debate on "Women and Question of Representation in Indian Politics", debate on "Aganipath Schemes: Pros and Cons", debate on "Social Media and Youth" was organized

Hindi Diwas -To commemorate the declaration of Hindi as an official language in India and to promote the use of Hindi, Hindi Diwas was celebrated in the college on 14th September, 2023. The students actively participated in Poem Recitation, Essay Writing, Spell Bee and Declamation Competition. Students from different classes unleashed their creative ideas on the Importance of Hindi language.

Essay writing Competition- Essay writing competition was organised by Dept of English, Govt College Barotiwala on dated 06/10/23. Around 155 students participated in competition. Topics for the competition were following: 1. The role of Education in woman empowerment 2. Culture and Diversity of Himachal Pradesh 3. Importance of English language 4. Self-reliant India 5. Contribution of Technology towards Education 6. Pollution due to urbanisation.

Road Safety Club: Road safety club organized Slogan writing, essay writing and poster making competition on the topic "do's and don'ts while on the road/driving", Quiz competition to raise the awareness about traffic signals.

- ☑ College got third position in Poster Making in the Inter-College Festival for the session 2023-24 Group Item creativity held at Govt. College Nalagarh, Distt. Solan w.e.f. 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> Sept,2023.
- The Annual Athletics Meet of Government College Barotiwala unfolded with grandeur and enthusiasm, showcasing the indomitable and competitive spirit of the students. The event held on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2024, brought together participants, volunteers, faculty and spectators in a celebration of sportsmanship and camaraderie. #### National Service Scheme (NSS)

National Service Scheme popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in the Gandhi centenary year, 1969 and was aimed at developing the personality of students through community service. Dr Niti Gupta is the NSS Program Officer and Shri Naveen Singh is the Office Incharge .

The college has 100 volunteers for the NSS unit in the current year 2023-24 as per the guidelines given by Himachal Pradesh University. The following programmes were initiated by the unit.

- Cleanliness Drive was organized in the college campus on 6<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2023. During these camps volunteers cleaned the college campus and surrounding areas.
- ☑ To promote "green earth" tree plantation drives were organised in the college campus on October 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and1<sup>st</sup> November. More than 50 plants were planted.
- A one-day camp was organised on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2024 in which volunteers cleaned the playground and surrounding areas and also prepared the ground for annual athletic meet.
- "My First Vote for the Country" campaign was organised in the campuson 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024 in which first time voters were motivated to come forward and exercise their democratic right to vote. After administering the oath to the students in this regard, a Slogan writing competition organised under this campaign.

#### 4 Extension Activities:

#### Career Guidance and Placement Cell

Career Guidance and Placement Cell of the college has been playing an important role in guiding the students about their career and tries it's best to equip the students with the necessary life skills irrespective of their background. In her role as the convenor, Prof Pallavi Chauhan spearheads the initiatives of the Cell. The following initiatives were taken under the cell this session:

•There was a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Nimbus Academy and Govt. College Barotiwala to guide students for various exams. The cell organised a Guest Lecture on Career Planning and Goal setting on 18th September 2023 in collaboration with Nimbus Academy Chandigarh.

- •The cell organised a special lecture on opportunities as a Make- up Artist and Self Grooming Tips. To provide our students a glimpse into the world of professional and skilled makeup artistry Ms Ritu Singh from Kaya Kalap Herbals Baddi was invited in the college.
- •Career Counselling and Placement Cell of in collaboration with Job Coach organised a job fair in 27th December 2023. The team from Job coach headed by Prof ML Sahani conducted a workshop with students.
- •The cell conducted Mock Interviews/ Interview Guidance for BCom/BA 3rd year students(on 26th & 27th February & 7th March 2024). The following points were highlighted and recommended to the students: 1. Skill Development 2. Confidence Building 3. Reducing Anxiety
  - · Identification of Strengths and Weaknesses.
- •The Cell organized a special lecture on "Navigating Examination Stress and an Overview of various Competitive Exams" in collaboration with Chanakya Academy, Chandigarh, on 11th March 2024. The session emphasized effective ways to manage exam stress and provided insights into how students can prepare for various competitive exams.
- •A second lecture on "Interview Skills and various options after Graduation" was conducted in collaboration with Baddi. This session aimed to equip students with valuable skills for job interviews and presented different career paths available post-graduation.

#### Anti - Drugs Club / Drug Prevention Squad

The Primary objective of an Anti-Drugs club in colleges is to create a supportive and an empowering environment that encourages students to make informed choices and live a healthy, drug -free lives. The Drug Prevention Squad in Govt. College, Barotiwala has been working under the able guidance of Dr Tripta Sharma sensitising the students about drug prevention and addiction.

- •The students were also delivered a lecture about drug addiction during orientation programme and during career counselling session on 18.09.23.
- •The club also had a collaborative session with the road safety club and a lecture by the doctor along with his team on drug addiction was held on 18.12.23.
- •A talk was delivered on drug abuse on 14/3/24 followed by an open discussion on the same. A short movie on drug addiction was also shown to the students.

#### **Rovers and Rangers**

Our college has one unit each of Rovers and Rangers functioning under the guidance of Prof Visheshar Lal and Dr Isha Dhiman.

The goal of the Movement is to help young people grow and reach their full potential in body, mind, social skills, and spiritual well-being. This includes becoming responsible members of society and making positive contributions to local and global communities.

During the academic session of 2023-24, the Rovers & Rangers unit of the college organized a tree plantation drive. On this occasion, members of the unit planted over 60 plants of various species in college campus.

#### Red Ribbon Club

Red Ribbon Club in colleges aims to spread awareness about HIV/AIDS. As the convenor, Dr Tripta Sharma and her team members organised following activities during the session.

- •HIV/AIDS awareness campaign was conducted by the Red Ribbon Club in Government College, Barotiwala on 07th and 09th March 2024.
- A Poster Making Competition, Slogan Writing Competition, Rangoli Competition and Essay Writing Competitions were organised. The students participated enthusiastically in these competitions.

#### **Eco Club**

At Govt. College, Barotiwala, Eco club was established to create consciousness about the clean and green environment and promote eco- friendly practices. Prof Visheshar Lal and his team members initiative several activities demonstrating their commitment to improving and maintaining the clean and green environment on campus.

#### College Wall Magazine "Expressions

In October 2023, the Department of Political Science, and the Department of History at Government College, Barotiwala, collaborated to establish a Wall Magazine called "Expressions." The magazine aims to offer students an open platform to express their creativity freely through articles, poems, photos, slogans, and posters. To oversee the publication process, an editorial board was formed. Prof Krishna Prakash and Prof Visheshar Lal play a key role in the activities of the Wall Magazine.

#### **Electoral Literacy Club**

At Government College, Barotiwala, the Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) was established with the aim of educating and informing students about elections, the electoral process, voter registration, voting patterns, practices, and issues in India. Prof Visheshar s able guidance propels the success of the club.

- •On 30/11/2023 a special voter awareness drive was started, and students were informed about the new voter registration. Students were informed about the form-6, Voter Helpline Application and voters.eci.gov.in website.
- •A week-long voter awareness campaign was started on 17/02/2024.

#### Women Cell

The role of Women Cell is to enlighten the women students and employees about their legal rights and to strive towards the empowerment of the women through the promotion of gender amity and programs concerning women welfare. Dr Anupama S Pathak leads the college Women Cell.

- •An awareness programme for the women staff was organized and the staff was made familiar with POSH act on 26th February 2024.
- •A "chai pe charcha" was conducted on 09th March 2024. where women staff discussed about their experiences and lessons learnt.

Road Safety Club: Nukad Natak on the theme "Sadak Suraksha Jiwan Raksha" Club organized healh check up camp with collaboration of East Man Auto Power Ltd. In which Dr. Manisha with her team member addressed the students and answers their queries and various routine body tests were done.

#### Report on the Annual Review Meeting on Student Outcomes

#### 1 Academic Performance:

The academic performance of students was reviewed based on examination results, project work, and overall classroom participation. It was observed that there is Improvement in pass percentages compared to the previous session. Need for enhanced support for students struggling in English.

#### 2 Co-curricular Activities:

Students participated in debates, quizzes, and workshops related to their academic fields. The focus was on developing communication and critical thinking skills. It was observed that students are participating but not in large number, but there is improvement in students' confidence and public speaking abilities.

#### 3 Extra-curricular Activities:

The students were involved in sports, arts, music, and other creative activities. Participation was encouraged at college level but very few at inter-college levels. Positive impact on student well-being and mental health was observed. But due to insufficient resources desired result were not observed.

#### 4 Extension Activities:

Extension activities included community outreach programs, environmental awareness campaigns, and volunteer work. Positive student feedback on experiential learning through outreach. There is need for more collaboration with external organizations.

#### Actions suggested for the session 2024-25 to achieve excellence.

The following actions were taken during the current session to improve outcomes:

#### 1 Academic Performance:

- Introduction of mentorship programs for personalized student support.
- Enhancing the use of technology .
- Encouraging participation in national / international academic competitions.
- Remedial classes and peer tutoring sessions will be conducted for underperforming students.
- -If needed use of digital platforms for online lectures and resources will be done.

#### 2 Co-curricular:

- -Organizing interdisciplinary workshops and conferences to raise students' exposure.
- collaboration with other departments for large-scale events.
- To enhance engagement of the student more interdepartmental events and online competitions will be organized .

#### 3 Extra-curricular:

- -A structured timetable will be introduced for extra-curricular activities.
- Initiatives to introduce new clubs for arts and technology.

#### 4 Extension:

- community outreach programs will be expanded to include skill development .
- student will be encouraged to greater participation in environmental and social initiatives.
- Collaborations with local NGOs will be initiated for community service opportunities.

#### Conclusion:

The meeting successfully identified the strengths /weaknesses and identified the areas for improvement in student for the current academic session. With a great focus on academic excellence, personal growth, and social responsibility, the action plan for the next session aims to foster holistic development of the student. Continued efforts and comprehensive monitoring of the overall development of the students will help in achieving the set goals for the upcoming academic year.
