

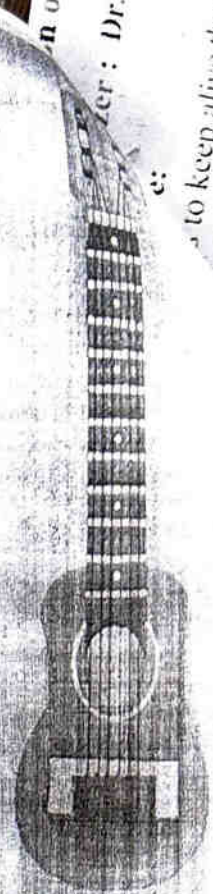
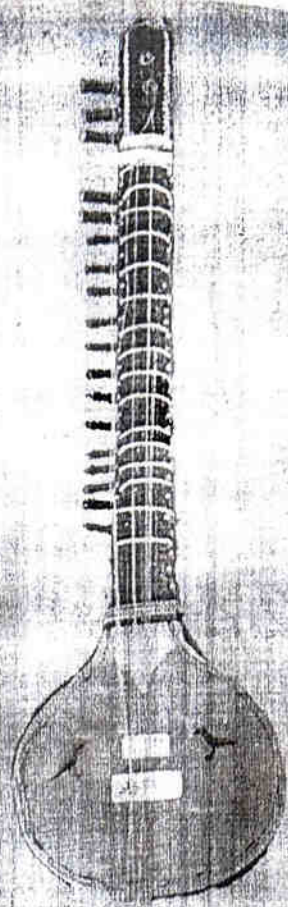
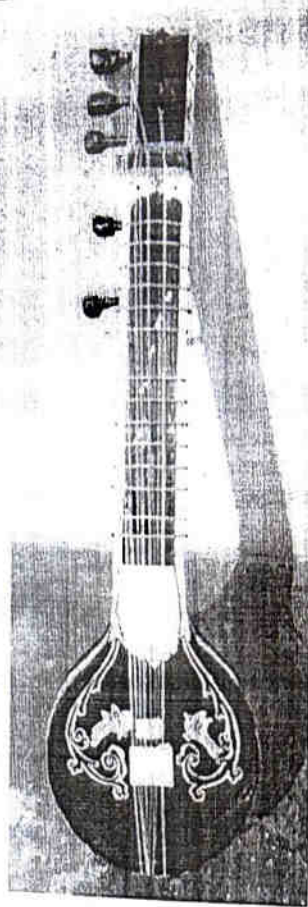

Modals & Charts on Musical Instruments :

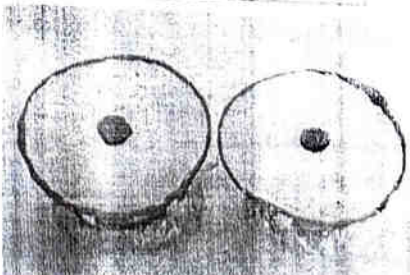
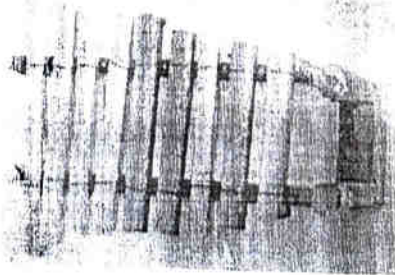
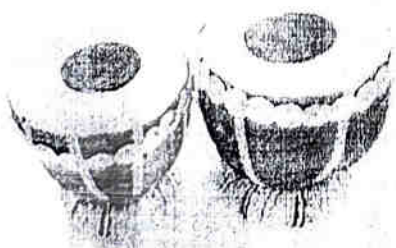
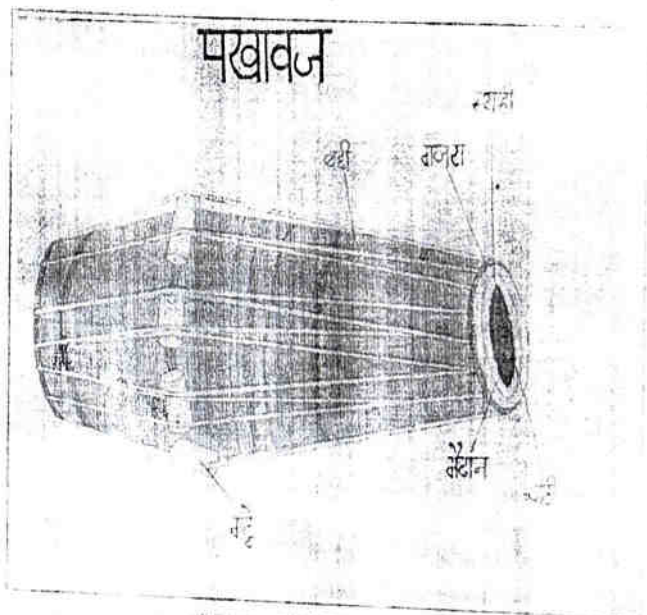

In a project during the session 2023-24, Dr. Niti Gupta tasked students to create models of Indian musical instruments, Sitar, Tabla, Xylophone and Guitar. The students enthusiastically worked on designing and creating miniature versions using a variety of materials. The students successfully completed their sitar models, demonstrating their creativity and teamwork, gaining a deeper understanding of the instrument's structure and cultural significance. The project aimed to combine artistic skills with a technical understanding of this classical instrument. The teacher provided information about the historical and cultural relevance of the sitar, as well as technical guidance on model building. Under her supervision, the students replicated key components such as the resonator, neck, frets and strings using materials such as wood, cardboard, wires and decorative elements. Through teamwork and creativity, the students successfully created accurate sitar models, enhancing their practical learning and appreciation for Indian classical music. The aim was to help students understand the structure and design of various traditional and contemporary musical instruments. Under the teacher's guidance, students used a variety of materials such as cardboard, wood, plastic, and wire to create their models. Each group focused on accurately replicating the main components of their assigned instrument. For the sitar, students designed the resonator, neck, and strings; for the tabla, they designed the drums and tension straps; for the xylophone, the bars and resonators were carefully arranged; and for the guitar, they replicated the body, strings, and frets. The teacher provided valuable information about the construction and cultural relevance of each instrument, helping students balance creativity with technical accuracy. Upon completion, students displayed their models, demonstrating not only craftsmanship but also a deep understanding of the instruments' musical roles and cultural significance.

...s to keep alive the traditional songs of the local dialect which are on the verge of extinction, to connect the younger generation with their culture which is getting distanced from their culture, to inculcate a sense of pride and respect towards the local culture. The initiative aims to preserve and promote the Pahari folk culture by engaging students in collecting traditional folk songs from the villagers. This activity promoted the connection between the younger generation and their cultural roots.

Key Activities:

1. Village Visit :

- A group of 5 students under the guidance of Dr. Niti Gupta visited the nearby villages of Patta Mehlog area over a period of one month.
- The students interacted with the elderly villagers to gather information about the traditional Pahari folk songs which are on the verge of extinction.

2. Song Collection and Documentation:

The students recorded various unique folk songs performed by the villagers. The lyrics and historical context of each song were documented for preservation.

Outcomes :

- Student engagement : Our students gained a deeper understanding of the Pahari culture and its musical heritage.
- Preservation of folk songs : Various traditional songs were collected and documented for future reference.
- Community involvement: Villagers expressed pride in seeing their cultural heritage valued and preserved by the younger generation.

Future plans:

The project will be expanded to include more villages and songs.
