The Student Feedback Session 2024–25 contains responses from 32 students, evaluating various aspects of their college experience. Here is an analysis based on the visible graphs and question topics:

Overall Satisfaction (Key Insights)

1. Teaching System

- Majority are either "Satisfied" or "Extremely Satisfied".
- Few or no students marked "Dissatisfied".

2. Facilities for Studies

- Similar satisfaction pattern: mostly positive.
- Mmajority of the respondents are satisfied.

3. Choice of Courses Offered

- Responses are leaning towards satisfaction with low dissatisfaction.

4. Staff Qualification & Teaching Methods

- Mostly "Extremely Satisfied" or "Satisfied".
- Minimal dissatisfaction.

5. Use of Smart Classrooms/ICT Tools

- Responses mostly vary between "Many" and "A few", suggesting limited but present usage.
- Very few selected "All" or "None" indicating a restricted use of smart classrooms

6. Digital Content Sharing

- Again, skewed towards "Many" and "A few", indicating inconsistent digital engagement.

7. Teaching & Engagement

- Seminars, Discussions, Debates: Mostly "Many" or "A few" teachers conduct them.

- Syllabus Completion: Highest responses at "90%" and "100%".
- Encouragement for Extracurriculars: Overwhelming "Yes" responses.
- Personality Grooming: Majority said "All" or "Many" teachers contribute.

8..Staff Behaviour & Institutional Requirements

- Punctuality: Mostly "Extremely Satisfied" and "Satisfied".
- 75% Attendance Rule: Almost unanimous "Yes".
- Office Staff Behavior: Positive trend.
- Discipline: High satisfaction8.

9. Academic Resources

- -Sports Activities: Mixed but mostly "Satisfied".
- Library Timings/Facilities: Generally positive.
- Library Book Quality: Mostly "Yes", some "Can't Say".
- Internal Assessment Sharing: Most students said "Yes".

9. Support Systems


- Grievance Redressal: Majority said "Yes", some "Can't Say".

- Sports and extracurricular engagement could be further improved.









